

PERSONALITIES AND THE CROSS



Our status before God is a gift he's given us through Jesus Christ.

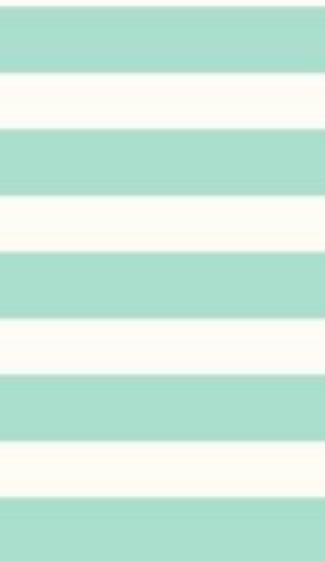

What I mean is this: One of you says, “I follow Paul”; another, “I follow Apollos”; another, “I follow Cephas”; still another, “I follow Christ.”

Paul — Founder of the church

Apollos — Skilled speaker

Cephas (Peter) — Connection to Jewish tradition

“I follow Christ” — No regard for human leadership

1 Corinthians 1:13-16 ^{NIV}

Is Christ divided? Was Paul crucified for you? Were you baptized in the name of Paul? ¹⁴ I thank God that I did not baptize any of you except Crispus and Gaius, ¹⁵ so no one can say that you were baptized in my name. ¹⁶ (Yes, I also baptized the household of Stephanas; beyond that, I don't remember if I baptized anyone else.)

1 Corinthians 1:17 ^{NIV}

For Christ did not send me to baptize, but to preach the gospel—
not with wisdom and eloquence, lest the cross of Christ be emptied
of its power.
