


THE PROMISE FULFILLED

The Invitation Extended

When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place.

ACTS 2:1 NIV



Suddenly a **sound** like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. ³ They **saw** what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. ⁴ All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.

ACTS 2:2-4 NIV

All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues (glossalalia) as the Spirit enabled them. ⁵ Now there were staying in Jerusalem God-fearing Jews from every nation under heaven. ⁶ When they heard this sound, a crowd came together in bewilderment, because each one heard their own language (dialekto) being spoken.

ACTS 2:4-6 NIV

Utterly amazed, they asked: "Aren't all these who are speaking Galileans? ⁸ Then how is it that each of us hears them in our native language? ⁹ Parthians, Medes and Elamites; residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, ¹⁰ Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya near Cyrene; visitors from Rome ¹¹ (both Jews and converts to Judaism); Cretans and Arabs—we hear them declaring the wonders of God in our own tongues!"

People tried to reach heaven


God divided people into many tongues


ACTS 2
